


## Living in an Urban Growth Area

  - 8. Kingston







#### **Project Expenditures by Need/Facilities Category**











#### **Traffic Demand Modeling**

- Computer simulation model
- Based on land use "trips" and general design characteristics of the roadway
  - Road segments
  - Theoretical volume to capacity (VC) ratio

The model's VC calculation simply show where there may be congestion and that it should be further evaluated and monitored










