Addendum 1 to Request for Quotation 2025-003 is to answer questions received.

1. Would the "2025 aramid fiber" proposal be considered null and void if the HMA supplier is to supply fiber to the HMA at their respective location? Or is the fiber RFQ in addition to the HMA aramid supply unit price RFQ?

ANSWER: No, RFQ #2025-003 is meant to be in addition to RFQ#2025-005, Partly due to KCPW limited staffing for HMA producers production facility.

2. If the aramid fiber contract is awarded, can the HMA supplier assume that the County will be procuring the fiber material and labor to introduce the fiber to the HMA as they have done in the years past?

ANSWER: No, KCPW staffing is critically low & at this time does not plan to staff the incorporation of procured fiber materials into planned 2025 activities.

3. In the HMA RFQ, the county would like a unit price for not only aramid fiber ½" HMA, but also aramid fiber 3/8" HMA which also makes both RFQ's hard to comprehend as the aramid fiber RFQ only mentions ½" HMA.

ANSWER: Oversight of NON-Clarity on our part, KCPW wishes for 3/8" & ½" HMA to be Fiber Reinforced by Suppliers in 2025.

DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE/PRODUCT

- The Supplier shall provide the Department of Public Works, ER&R Division (Kitsap County) with the appropriate quantity of aromatic polyamide (aramid) fiber sufficient AS DEFINED IN ASTM D8395-23 "STANDARD SPECIFICATION FOR ARAMID FIBER FOR ASPHALT MIXTURES" to be blended with 10328 tons of Class ½", PG 58H -22 Hot Mix Asphalt.
- 2) The Supplier shall provide Aramid Fiber conforming to the following

requirements: Length:	¾ inch (19 mm)
Form:	Fibrillated, monofilament, or cut fiber clips
Specific Gravity:	Aramid,
1.44 Tensile Strength:	≥ 400,000
p.s.i. Operating Temp:	-100°F -
800°F	
Release Agent:	Sasobit or Polyolefin

The Supplier shall deliver fiber materials to 2339 SE Cedar Road, Port Orchard, WA. 98366, and shall provide for unloading capability. Materials will be stored beneath canopy at this location, as directed by County staff. Fiber shall be delivered in sealed, undamaged containers with labels intact and legible, indicating material name and lot number
