Notice of Request for Proposals (RFP): 2026 Treatment Sales Tax Funding

Submission Deadline: June 30, 2025 at 12:00 p.m.

The Kitsap County **Mental Health, Chemical Dependency, and Therapeutic Court Tax Program** (Treatment Sales Tax) is pleased to announce the release of its **2026 Request for Proposals (RFP)**.

Available Funding: Approximately **\$7.4 million** will be awarded for projects and services delivered between **January 1 and December 31, 2026**. With 25% of the released funds awarded to the Therapeutic Courts.

Approved by ordinance in 2013, the 1/10th of 1% sales and use tax is designated for annual distribution to service providers, businesses, and organizations that administer **mental health, substance use, and therapeutic court programs** in Kitsap County.

Funding Priorities

All proposals must use Treatment Sales Tax funding solely to support the operation or delivery of:

- Mental health treatment services
- Chemical dependency treatment services
- Therapeutic court programs

Eligible services may include (but are not limited to):

- Youth mental health and treatment services
- Housing integrated into behavioral health programs
- Behavioral health stabilization, treatment, and services
- Gambling treatment services
- Case management and transportation

Key Application Dates

- **Pre-Application Form Required:** May 2–May 16, 2025
- **Full Proposal Deadline:** June 30, 2025 by 12:00 p.m.

Note: Only organizations that submit a pre-application form by May 16 will be eligible to submit a full proposal.
