This first addendum to RFQ 2026-024 RFQ KITSAP 29 UTILITY RELOCATIONS Addressed questions received.

1. I am interested in the Kitsap 29 Utility Relocation RFQ and would like to know if an 11x17 page can be used in the SOQ.

Response: *The SOQ may include up to two 11x17 trifold pages, each of which counts as one page.*

2. Part 5 in the scoring criteria has no section above with clarifying information about what is requested for this section and from the scoring values is the most important section. Can you provide any clarifying information or guidance on what should be covered in this section?

Response: *Part 5 was erroneously included in Table 2. Table 2 is hereby revised as follows:*

- For the sewer forcemain included in this RFQ, will Kewitt, the design-builder, be performing the construction?

Response: *No, WSDOT/Kiewit has requested that Kitsap County handle relocations separately from their project.*

- For the construction lead/services element, can you clarify the extents of services requested? ESDC? Inspection? Other? The extent of services has not been established at this time.

Response: *The solicitation covers services the County may require, including construction support (e.g., construction engineering support, construction management, and/or construction inspection services).*

- Does this RFQ include ONLY the sewer design? E.g. should the design package include TESC, site prep, restoration plans, etc?

Response: *No, the PS&E will be a comprehensive package that includes TESC, site prep, restoration plans, etc.*

- If known, when is this project expected to go to bid for contractors and what is the expected start date for construction?

Response: *Tentative bid dates have not been established at this time.*

7. We are interested in bidding for the above project. I am just reaching out to confirm that the geotechnical scope can be bid separately?

Response: *Prospective firms submitting statements of qualifications must include a geotechnical engineering subconsultant.*
