Utility Division Six-Year Capital Facilities Plan (CFP)

Recommended Action: Motion to Adopt Resolution Establishing the Kitsap County Public Works Sewer Utility Six-Year Facilities Plan (2025-2030)

Summary: In compliance with RCW 36.70A.130(2)(a)(iv) and KCC 21.08.020, Kitsap County Department of Public Works, Sewer Utility has conducted assessments of the County owned/operated municipal sanitary sewer systems and has developed the attached Six-Year Capital Facilities Plan (CFP). The CFP shows projects and associated costs for 13 sanitary sewer treatment and collection system improvements from January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2030. The Kitsap County Comprehensive Plan is updated annually with the current approved CFP.

> The six-year list of improvement projects has been developed from the 20-year sewer facility plans, recent technical memorandums, and maintenance records for Central Kitsap, Kingston, Suguamish. The projects were selected based on evaluation of capacity needs, future DOE regulation changes, infrastructure in use past its service life, and the potential for system failures

WHEREAS, in further compliance with said RCW, the Board of Kitsap County Commissioners has held a public hearing on the 25th day of November, 2024.

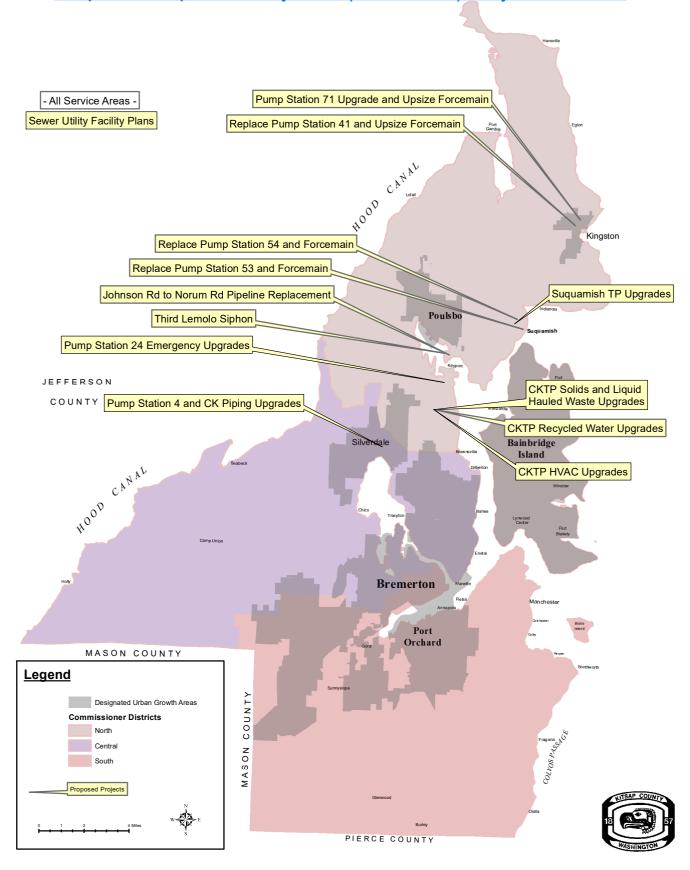

This incorporation by reference replaces and updates the Sewer section, specifically the subsection entitled "Capital Facilities Projects and Financing: 2025 - 2030." The portions of the Sewer Division Six-Year Capital Facilities Plan that are incorporated are only those components necessary for the Capital Facilities Plan, as set forth in the current Capital Facilities Plan.
