1. FELONY DIVERSION PROGRAM

I have been charged with the following felony crime(s) –

These charges have been filed in Kitsap County District Court and I am enrolled in the Felony Diversion Program. I understand that if I violate the terms of my agreement with the Court and the Prosecutor's Office, my participation in the Felony Diversion Program may be terminated and my case will be filed in Kitsap County Superior Court.

2. WAIVER OF EXTRADITION

I have been granted permission to travel out of state while I am enrolled in the Felony Diversion Program. Because I have received permission to travel outside the State of Washington, I hereby agree to waive extradition to the State of Washington from any state or territory of the United States, or from the District of Columbia, or from any other point outside the State of Washington should it be the case that I am found outside the State of Washington and I am subject to return to stand trial in the matter. I also agree that I will not contest any effort to return me to the State of Washington.

I make this waiver of extradition freely, voluntarily and without compulsion. No one has threatened harm of any kind to me or any other person to cause me to make this waiver. No person has made promises of any kind to cause me to make this waiver, except as set forth in this agreement. I have been informed and fully understand that by waiving extradition, I am waiving the following rights: (a) the right to issuance and service of a warrant of extradition; (b) the right to obtain a writ of habeas corpus under RCW 10.88.290 or another state's version of the Uniform

Criminal Extradition Act; (c) the right to counsel with respect to extradition proceedings; and (d) the opportunity to petition the executive of the asylum state for relief from extradition.

I have also been informed and fully understand that once I sign this agreement, the waiver of extradition is irrevocable.
