

Adult Family Home Permit

What is an Adult Family Home?

An Adult Family Home (AFH) is a residential home licensed to care for up to six non-related residents (RCW 70.128.010). Adult Family Homes are licensed through the Washington Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS). DSHS requires Adult Family Homes to have a Building Code Inspection completed through the local jurisdiction where the home is located.

What is the process?

- **Step 1)** Contact DSHS to begin the process. DSHS provides [additional information](#) on applications, qualifications, and training requirements on their website under [Information for AFH Prospective Providers](#).
- **Step 2)** Complete an Adult Family Home application through our [Application Portal](#). This application will prompt you to upload documents based on answers provided in the application survey questions. This will include a detailed Floor Plan, as outlined in the permit application.
 - **Important: If remodel work is needed for your AFH, a separate building permit for remodel is required.** Common items include ramps, changing windows, adding rooms, and bathroom fixture spacing. Apply for a separate remodel permit for any work, as instructed through the Application Portal. *Remodel permit must be complete prior to calling for final Adult Family Home inspection.*
- **Step 3)** Once your Adult Family Home permit is issued, you will request your Adult Family Home inspection.
- **Step 4)** Once your final Adult Family Home inspection is completed, finish your DSHS requirements. You will have a completed Adult Family Home Building Inspection Checklist from a building inspector to provide to DSHS.
