PROGRAMMATIC DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of Proposal: **2026 Comprehensive Plan Update: PROS Element and Capital Facilities Plan and Silverdale Center Plan.** This State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) decision is for updates to the Kitsap County Comprehensive Plan. The annual Comprehensive Plan Amendment will include updating the Parks, Recreation, and Open Space (PROS) Element and the Capital Facilities Plan to include information from the recently adopted Parks PROS Plan and updating the Silverdale Center Plan. The Comp Plan and Capital Facilities Plan were adopted by ordinance in December 2024, and the PROS Plan was subsequently adopted by resolution in 2025. The Comp Plan does not currently reference the adopted 2025 PROS Plan and its updated information. There will be no substantive amendments to the PROS Plan from when it was adopted and the Comp Plan amendment is considered procedural.

The current Silverdale Regional Center Subarea Plan, aka Silverdale Center Plan, was updated as part of the 2024 Comprehensive Plan update, but greater detail is needed in a completely refreshed and improved Subarea Plan, including more detail related to Kitsap's designated 'regional growth center' development, public investment, transportation improvements, design standards, and development code. The evolution of Silverdale Regional Center is a key aspect of the County and Regional Growth Strategy.

Proponent: Kitsap County Department of Community Development

Lead Agency: Kitsap County

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: County-wide

The lead agency for this programmatic, non-project action has determined that the project does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the



environment. Accordingly, an environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.
