### ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- Marsha shared that there have been 16 motor vehicle accident deaths this year in Kitsap. She also shared that the **Night of 1000 Stars** is on December 13<sup>th</sup>.
- Naomi shared that the Naloxone/Narcan Train the Trainers is going to expand to overdose education throughout the community.

### PARTNER HIGHLIGHTS:

- Steve shared an update on the Quick Start cards (drug cards). He has been working with Naomi and Kelly on these and they are well underway. He shared examples of them with the group. They will continue the work and are hoping to have them done by the end of February, in hopes to hand out at the SAP “meet and greet” event.
- Deanne shared about the “meet and greet” event. It will be held at the end of February 2025, potentially at the Silverdale library. The intention is to have prevention partners attend. There will be trainings and networking time. The goal is to invite about 60 people.
- Deanne shared that the current activities the coalition is already involved in include Guiding Good Choices, Positive Action, various community outreach measures, capacity building, community and staff trainings, public awareness/media campaigns, CMCA with vaping.
- The group participated in a brainstorming activity discussing ideas of potential future events, goals, community needs, etc.
- Rene reported that she has kids that express concern about substance abuse/misuse within their homes. She advises these kids to “choose not to use”.
