Culvert Replacement Project

Kitsap County Department of Public Works is replacing a deteriorating 36-inch diameter culvert under NW Newberry Hill Rd with a fish passable concrete box culvert.

Project Will:

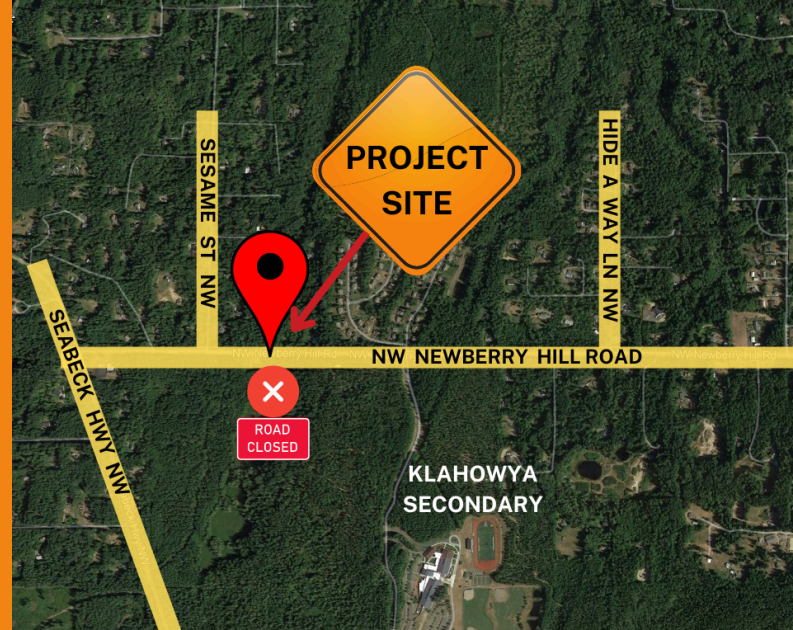
- Replace a failing culvert at Little Anderson Creek with a new concrete box culvert
- Enhance stream function and fish passage
- Reconnect the natural wildlife corridor
- Maintain the roadway function for vehicles, pedestrians, and bicycles

What to Expect:

- NW Newberry Hill Rd will be closed in the immediate vicinity of the project throughout the summer vacation period of Klahowya Secondary School. This closure is aimed at expediting the project's completion, enhancing cost-effectiveness, and ensuring the safety of both work crews and motorists
- A detour route will be posted prior to the road closure
- Access to private driveways will not be impacted
